Registration Deadline: Since classes fill quickly, it is advisable to get your payment and registration forms in A.S.A.P. However, Artwell will be accepting payment and registration forms up to one week prior to the first session of the class you wish to take.

Payment methods: Cash, check, MC or Visa.

Gallery Rules: Classes will be held in the main gallery space or Creative Learning Center. Artwork may be on exhibition in the main gallery while the classes are running. Children are not allowed to roam freely in the gallery, nor to touch the work or climb on pedestals. The gallery phone may only be used for emergency or local calls. The office machines are solely reserved for Artwell staff.
